Favorite Performers - Creedence Clearwater Revival, Crow, Masson Proffit, and Mickey Mouse of Course!

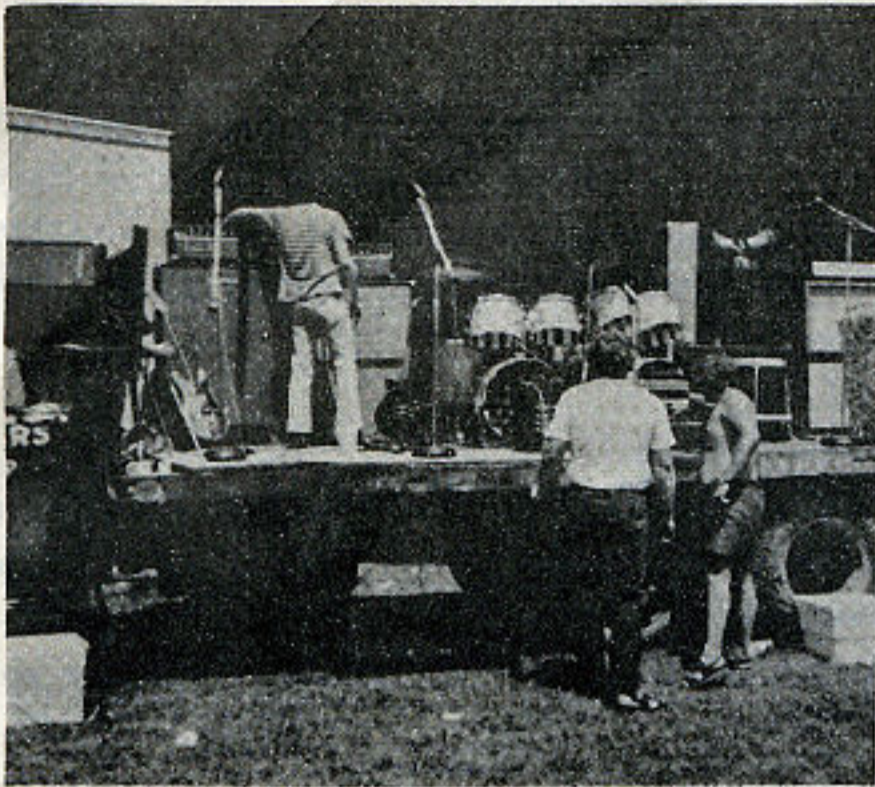
Hobbies - Citizen's Band Radio, and working with electronics of all kinds.

As you know the "Wild Cherries" do a lot of traveling. They're almost always on the road making "in-person" appearances around the midwest. And that's just how you can meet them. Without ever leaving your hometown! All you have to know is WHERE they are going to be - and WHEN they are going to be there!

Whenever possible, the "Wild Cherries" arrive in a city several hours BEFORE their "in-person" appearance. If there's a Holiday Inn in your town - chances are that's where the "Wild Cherries" will be staying. However, don't fret if there's no Holiday Inn - just check the best motel in your area or nearest to the place they will be playing. The "Cherries" is bound to be at ONE of these places! (In some cases however, the "Wild Cherries" engagement schedule is so heavy that they must travel on.)

The "Wild Cherries" usually spend their free hours touring the town, so don't be surprised if you bump into Rick and Dennis at your neighborhood hang-out (like a roller skating rink) or run into Pat and Greg at the local swimming pool or Steve at a shopping center or music store! You may be lucky enough to meet all of the "Wild Cherries" cause they usually wander around town together. And they'll probably be WALKING - so you'll be sure not to miss seeing them!

On the night of the dance - they don't have very much spare time. They arrive at the place of their "live performance" two or three hours BEFORE playing time, so they can rehearse, allow time to take care of last minute adjustments, and yes, meet some of their fans! After their performance, the "Wild Cherries" usually go out to eat - in the most popular restaurant in town. After dinner, you can usually find them at the motel (if they are staying in your town) taking a swim in the motel pool before retiring for the night.

As you can see there are many opportunities for you to meet and get to know the "Wild Cherries". The thing to remember is - the "Wild Cherries" really do want to meet you! In fact, the "Cherries" literally go out of their way to say "Hello" to their fans. That's because to the "Wild Cherries", a "fan" is a "friend" -- a very special kind of friend!
